

MLFA Student Code of Conduct Agreement

Participants are expected to behave in a way that respects themselves, those around them, and the building where they are competing. They are expected to refrain from conduct that is disruptive in nature or disrespects the space.

1. The use of cell phones and other electronic devices during rounds of competition is prohibited. All cell phones and other electronic devices must be **turned off** while speaking rounds are in session.
2. Participants must refrain from language, which intentionally demeans an ethnic group, gender, religious beliefs, or any groups/individuals. Students must treat each other with respect at all times.
3. Participant behavior should be attentive and supportive in and out of rounds of competition. During rounds, they should never put their heads down during another competitor's performance. Competitors should refrain from creating any distracting noises, negative/disruptive comments, or movements during rounds of competition.
4. Participants must move quietly through the halls, especially while rounds of competition are still session. They must walk, not run, through the buildings hosting the competition.
5. When not competing in rounds of competition, competitors are to remain in the areas designated for the students by the host school (i.e. gym, cafeteria, etc...). Competitors should not be wandering the halls in their free time.
6. All competitors are expected to clean the messes they create and be willing to assist in the tidying of areas that need attention, leaving the spaces where they ate, hung out, and competed in the same condition that they found them.

Head coaches, tournament hosts, and/or the MLFA will carry out appropriate consequences if these expectations are not met.
